Finance Minister Ali Hassan Khalil referred a case of fraudulent payment notices to the Financial Public Prosecutor, through the Committee of Cases at the Ministry of Justice. The case was uncovered when an audit was carried out by the IT Department at the Ministry of Finance prior to the write-off of settled receipts. Indeed, it appeared that there was no trace of these receipts in the cashiers' system.

Minister Khalil asked the Financial Public Prosecutor to carry out the required investigation and prosecute, in the form of a personal action, all those involved in paying the Built Property Tax using the suspected notices . He also requested the prosecution of all those found guilty of committing, taking part or intervening in the felony, as stipulated by Article 3 of legislative decree no. 156/83, asking to follow up with them or any other judiciary competent body.

Minister Khalil referred the same case to the head of the Central Inspection Board to ensure he is informed of the situation and that he will undertake the needed investigation and report his findings to the Ministry of Finance.
