Following on the news about the Lebanese Customs seizing expired medicine in a warehouse in Damour, Chouf, the DG of the Customs Administration, Badri Daher, stated that upon receiving relevant information, the competent bodies at the Customs were tasked to follow up on the matter and investigate. After informing Finance Minister Ali Hassan Khalil, the Head of Beirut Customs Bureau supported the Head of the Land Prevention unit at the Regional Customs Division in Beirut in raiding the warehouse and seizing expired medicine worth millions of Lebanese Liras. It turned out that some of these expired medications have made it to the local market.

Investigations are ongoing to uncover the details of this operation, arrest involved suspects and discover the quantity diverted to the local market. The Public Prosecution Office was informed and is undertaking thorough investigations. The case was also transferred to the Financial Crimes Division.
